A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO AN ADVISORY SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR A NEW CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING DUTIES AND SUNSET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission terminated its City Attorney on April 24, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 2-243(b) of the Code of Ordinances requires that upon the determination of the need for hiring of a new City Attorney, the City Commission shall by resolution set the hiring criteria as set forth in Sec. 2-150(b)(1)-(4) within one month; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has expressed an intent to find the most qualified candidate to fill the position of Key West City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, members of the City Commission find that it would be beneficial to assemble a committee of citizens and staff with interest and expertise about the skills and experience necessary for a superior City Attorney, to provide recommendations during the search process; and

WHEREAS, it is the Commission's desire to limit Advisory Screening Committee candidates to full-time City residents or living full-time south of Mile Marker 33 and have full-time employment in the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That individual appointments to the Advisory Screening Committee are as follows:

Section 2: That the Committee shall conduct its initial meeting following the establishment of preferred criteria by the City Commission for the selection of a new City Attorney.

Section 3: That the Committee shall review all applications for the position of City Attorney and provide a list of recommended applicants to the City Commission for consideration.

Section 4: That the Committee shall be governed by the Uniform Procedures for Advisory Boards found in Chapter 2, Division 2 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, except that all members shall be full-time City residents or live full-time south of Mile Marker 33 and have full-time employment in the City. The Committee shall sunset upon submitting recommendations to the City Commission

for a new City Attorney.
