

## **Monthly Key West Police Department Report**

Subject: Monthly Report - August 2025

In August 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 4,935 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,726 came directly to 911. Compared to August 2024, we experienced a 4.7% decrease in 911 calls, and a 5.2% decrease in non-emergency calls.

Officers completed 473 police reports and 110 arrests were made. Compared to August 2024, police reports decreased by 14.3 % and arrests decreased by 19.1%.

A total of 1,128 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 237 citations and 262 written warnings.
