A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE WESLEY HOUSE FAMILY SERVICES, INC. TO CONDUCT ITS ANNUAL "VALENTINE'S DAY FUNDRAISER" AT THE CURRY MANSION LOCATED AT 511 CAROLINE STREET ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2022, FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 11:30 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CAROLINE STREET FROM DUVAL STREET TO SIMONTON STREET AND ANN STREET FROM GREENE STREET TO CAROLINE STREET FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 11:30 P.M; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 11:30 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE BARRICADED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That In Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City”

SECTION 3. That the Wesley House Family Services, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct "Valentine's Fundraiser" on the days and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the city is executed;

provided the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That the Wesley House Family Services, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the closure of Caroline Street between Duval and Simonton Streets and Ann Street from Greene Street to Caroline Street on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 5. That the Wesley House Family Services, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 6. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, permission is granted to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 7. That Sloppy Joe's must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 8. That Wesley house Family Services, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 9. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by the Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the community.

SECTION 10. That this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
