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I object due to inadequate public notice and formally request that this item be postponed. The public was given only four business days to review lengthy and complex agenda materials. That is plainly insufficient for meaningful review or participation.

This lack of notice mirrors the transparency failures identified in the recent Grand Jury's recommendations. Proceeding under these conditions undermines public trust and informed decision-making.

While I was able to submit limited comments on Agenda Item #21, the notice period did not allow time to analyze the broader, interconnected issues involved. If this timeline prevents a meaningful response from someone with legal experience, it effectively excludes the public altogether.

For these reasons, this item should be postponed to allow adequate review and genuine public input.
