A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE BAHAMA VILLAGE MUSIC PROGRAM TO HOLD THE 10TH CROOKS ANNUAL SECOND LINE PARADE ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2025, FROM 2:00 P.M. TO 4:00 P.M. ON DUVAL STREET; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 2:00 P.M. TO 4:00 P.M; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Bahama Village Music Program wishes to conduct the "10th Crooks Annual Second Line Parade" on Duval Street from the Hog's Breath Saloon to the Green Parrot during the hours of 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on February 16, 2025; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

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SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That the Bahama Village Music Program is hereby granted permission to hold the 10th Crooks Annual Second Line Parade starting at Front Street and Duval Street and ending at Southard Street and Whitehead Street on Saturday, February 16, 2025, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

SECTION 4. That the Bahama Village Music Program will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
