

Habitat for Humanity: Bahama Village Scattered Sites

Project Details:

- Homes will be constructed by Habitat on 3 scattered sites in Bahama Village
- Land is leased to Habitat with 99-year leases from the KWH
- Homes will be sold to qualified low-median income homeowners with 30-year 0% interest mortgages
- Sale prices will be based on city sales limits and subsidy will be layered to keep monthly housing costs affordable to families in designated income brackets

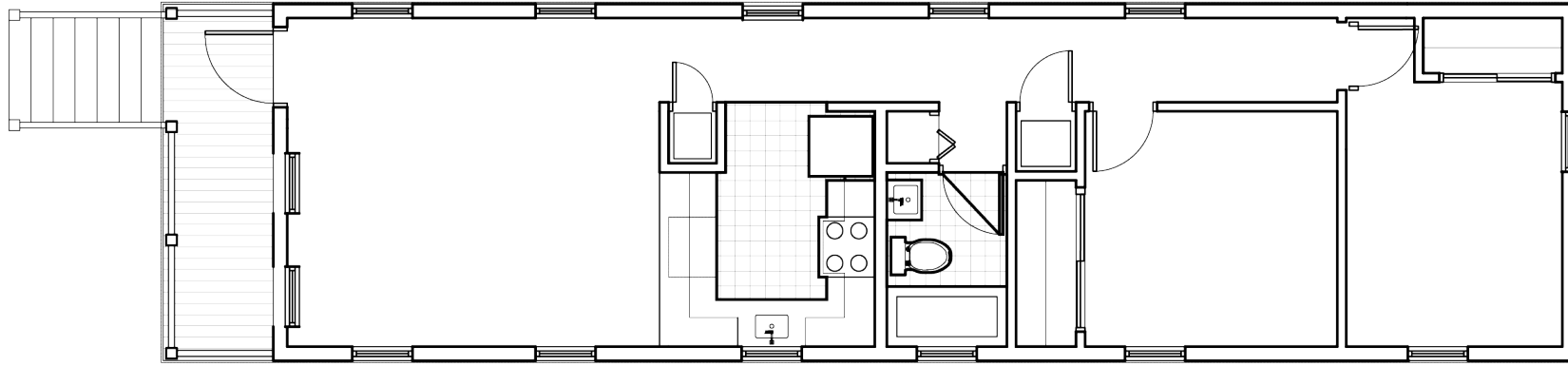

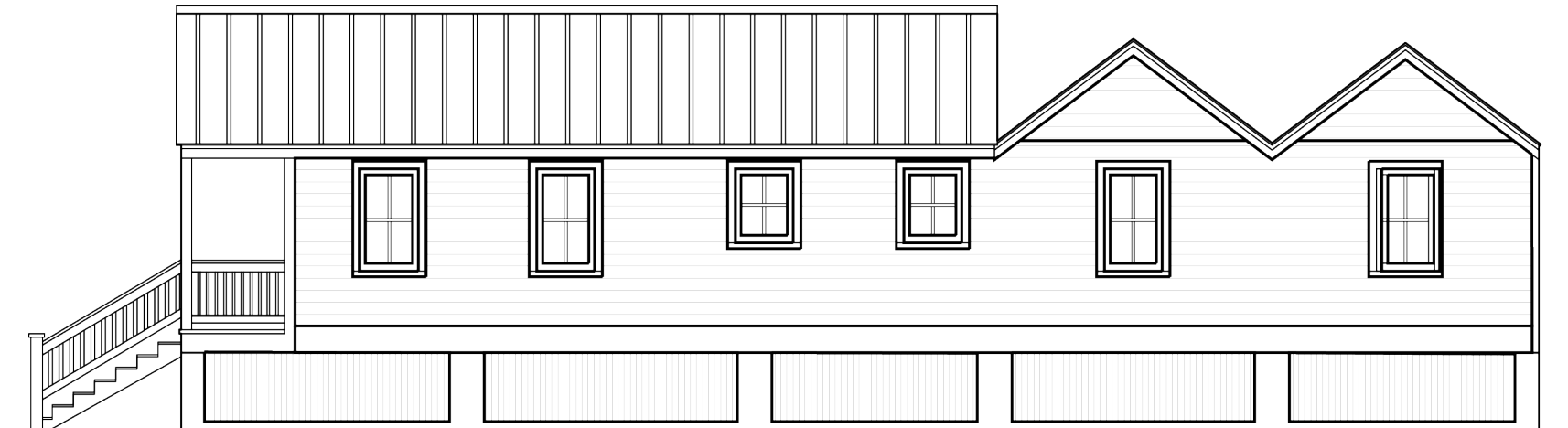


304 Truman Avenue

Shown are preliminary drawings provided to KWHA by Bill Horn for 870 sq. ft. home on this property. Final plans may differ.

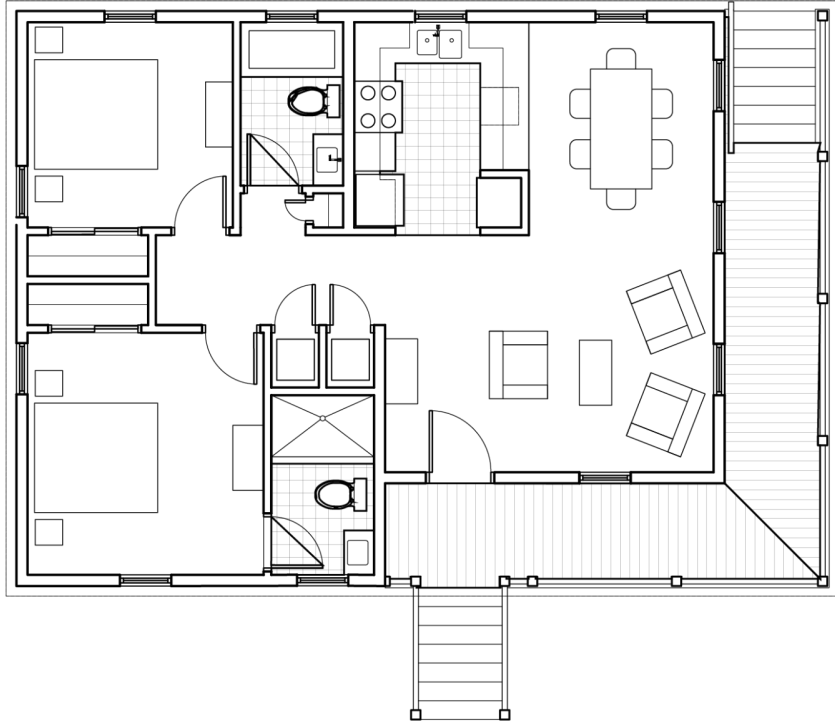


Current site

Shown are preliminary drawings provided to KWHa by Bill Horn for 1144 sq. ft. home on this property. Final plans may differ.

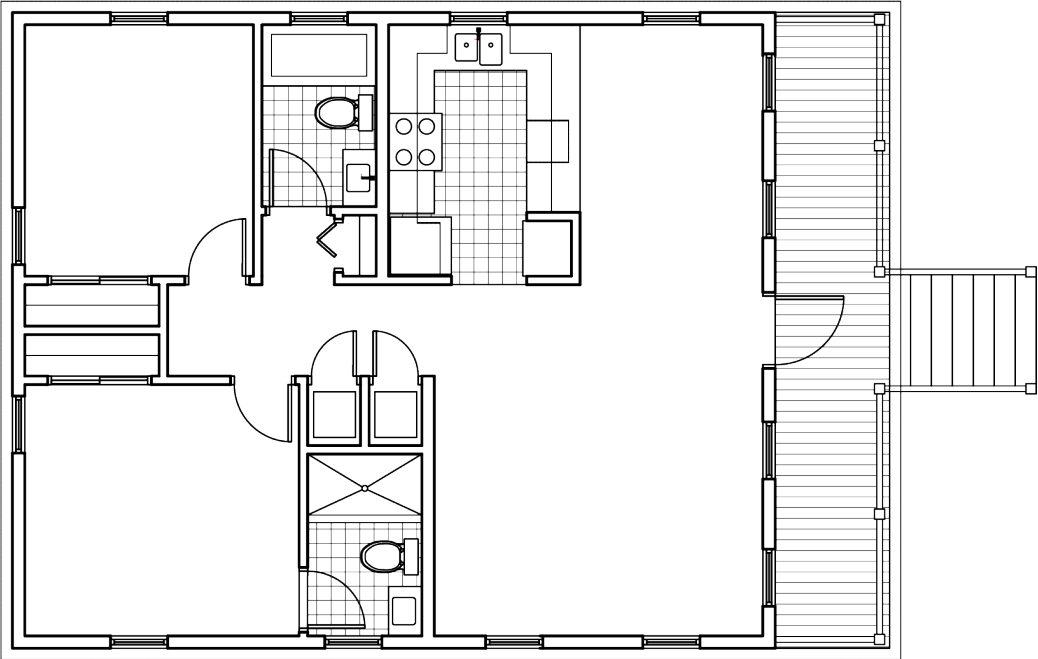


Current site
