A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING TASK ORDER 4-22 ENG FROM CH2M HILL ENGINEERS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$83,934.00 FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO DEVELOP A PILOT PROJECT TO ESTABLISH A PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAM FOCUSED ON EARLY LIFE CYCLE TECHNIQUES TO EXTEND PAVEMENT LIFE; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-207, the City Commission approved a contract with CH2M Hill, Inc. for General Engineering Services, in Resolution 20-142 the contract was extended, and in Resolution 22-171 the contract was extended through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, after completion of the Pavement Management Analysis Report in 2019, the City determined that it is important to work towards extending pavement life, rather than focusing only on the lowest rated streets; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends authorization of this Task Order to work towards a pilot program focused on early life cycle techniques, which will enhance the health, welfare and safety of residents and visitors of the City of Key West; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order 4-22 ENG from CH2M Hill Engineering, Inc. to Develop a Pavement Rehabilitation Pilot program to Implement Early Life Cycle Techniques is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$83,934.00.

Section 2: That funds for this project are budgeted in the Internal Improvements/Gas Tax Fund account #102-4102-541-6300, Project Code II41022202, and any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby approved.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
