A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SOLE-SOURCE PROCUREMENT OF A SERVICE PACKAGE FOR LEADSONLINE POWERPLUS INVESTIGATION SYSTEM SERVICE PACKAGE SOFTWARE, PURSUANT TO CITY ORDINANCES SEC. 2-797(1)(A) AND SEC. 2-844 (A)&(B) FROM WEATHERBY PARENT, LLC dba LEADSONLINE, LLC IN AN INITIAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$8,275.00 FOR FIRST 12 MONTHS OF AN AGREEMENT FOR UP TO THREE-YEARS; AUTHORIZING BUDGET TRANSFERS AND APPROVING THE USE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS STATE FORFEITURE ACCOUNT FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1) permits the purchase of goods and services without competition on a sole source basis under certain specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes section 932.7055 provides authority for the expenditure of state police forfeiture funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached agreement for the procurement of a 12-month service package of LeadsOnline PowerPlus Investigation Service Package Software from Weatherby Parent, LLC dba LeadsOnline, LLC pursuant to Key West Code of Ordinances sections 2-797(1)(a) and 2-844 (a) & (b), in an initial amount not to exceed \$8,275.00 for the first 12 months of an agreement for up to three years of service, in accordance with the November 16, 2022 quotation from LeadsOnline is hereby approved.

Section 2: That \$8,275.00 for the first year of this procurement will be authorized and allocated in FY 22/23 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, State forfeiture funds account #172-2111-521-5400. A contract amount of up to 24,825.00 (\$8,275.00 per year) over three budget years is authorized. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby approved.

Section 4: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
