A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PARTIAL RESCISSION OF RESOLUTION NO. 24 - 040RESCINDING PROCUREMENT FROM EleGARD SYSTEMS TO PROVIDE HIGH PERFORMANCE RESUSCITATION FOR TRAINING AND DEVICES FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL; AUTHORIZING PROCUREMENT OF THREE (3) STRYKER LUCAS CHEST COMPRESSION RESUSCITATION SYSTEMS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,115.38 TO BE FUNDED THROUGH THE AWARDED FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER то EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, ANY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR OTHER NECESSARY DOCUMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2024 the Commission approved Resolution No. 24-040 authorizing acceptance of a grant from the Florida Department of Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Community Support Grant for High Performance Resuscitation Training (SOW23-347) in the amount of \$54,600.00 towards procurement of seven EleGARD Systems and personnel training to equip emergency vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest to procure the most advanced High Performance Resuscitation systems and training now available; and

WHEREAS, the Stryker Lucas Chest Compression System is now the most advanced high performance resuscitation system utilized by Fire Departments throughout the State of Florida for its effectiveness; and WHEREAS, staff now desires to purchase the Stryker Lucas Chest Compression Systems in the amount of \$54,115.38 to make best use of the awarded grant funding received through the Florida Department of Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Community Support Grant for high performance resuscitation and training;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSIOM OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby rescinds approval of the purchase of high performance resuscitation systems from EleGARD and authorizes the purchase of the Stryker Lucas Chest Compression Systems and training in the amount of \$54,115.38 to be paid through the grant funding awarded to the City through the Florida Department of Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Community Support Grant.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any contracts, budget transfers or other necessary documents needed to facilitate this purchase.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
