On 1/15/22, Sgt. Siracuse and I (Ofc. Arguello) went out with the owner of the School bus (VA tag BOWT13D) pictured above. Sgt. Siracuse educated the owner about City Ordinances and made him aware that it's unlawful to sleep inside his bus in the city of Key West. The Owner of the bus stated he could not afford to pay campground fees and was going to stay in Key West for a few days. The School bus has been turned into a Recreational Vehicle as you can see from the above picture. The owner was warned about camping and illegally parking (due to the size of the bus) in the city of Key West.

I wrote a parking ticket for the parking violation and attempted to contact the vehicle occupants. I knocked several times on the bus door and windows. I observed a large dog which was at the front door to the bus. I called Sergeant Rodriguez and consulted with him about the incident. Sergeant Rodriguez responded to the scene. We assumed the bus was empty and decided to tow it and to have the SPCA respond to take possession of the dog. We made several more attempts to warn any persons who may have been inside the bus.

We were waiting for the SPCA and tow company to respond. The bus's engine suddenly started and the covers on the front windows were gone. I maneuvered my patrol vehicle in front of the bus, to prevent it from fleeing. We observed Matthew Davey, the owner of the bus, inside the bus. We beckoned him outside. Matthew told us he was unaware of the consequences of lodging in a motor vehicle. Sergeant Rodriguez called Sergeant Siracuse and asked about the encounter described in the BOLO. Sergeant Siracuse confirmed Matthew was warned about the consequences.

I detained Matthew, transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center and turned him over to the detention deputies without incident. Matthew's dog was turned over to this girlfriend, who was also on the bus. Matthew's bus was towed by Arnold's Towing.

I activated my bodycam and in-car camera during this call.

Matthew did violate City Ordinance 70-130-NO LODGING IN VEHICLES by lodging in his RV while parked on a public right-of-way in the City of Key West.
