#### ANNUAL WATER RATE INDEX

The water rate will be automatically adjusted each year (on May 1<sup>st</sup>) unless specifically not approved by the FKAA Board of Directors. The Water Rate Index adjustment reflects inflationary increases in the cost of providing service. The Water Rate Index formula is that as established by the Public Service Commission which is an amount derived by the percentage change in the Gross Domestic Product Implicit Price Deflator Index (GPD Index) as published by the Florida Public Service Commission annually. The formula is:

## GDP Index X Prior Fiscal Year Annual Operating Expenses Prior Fiscal Year Annual Water Rate Revenue

Note:

March 26, 2003...The Consumption Charge was increased by Water Rate Index adjustment formula (.92%); however, the Board waived the automatic adjustment to the Base Facility Charge for 2003. March 18,2004....The Consumption Charge was increased by Water Rate Index adjustment formula (1%); however, the Board waived the automatic adjustment to the Base Facility Charge for 2004. March 24, 2005.... The Consumption Charge and the Base Facility Charges were increased by the Water Rate Index adjustment formula (1.58%) effective 5/1/05. 2006... The Consumption Charge and the Base Facility Charge were automatically increased by the Water Rate Index adjustment formula (2.02%) effective 5/1/06. 5/2007.... The Consumption Charge, the Base Facility Charge and the Fire Service Monthly Rate were automatically increased by the Water Rate Index adjustment formula (2.59%) effective 5/1/07. 2007... The Consumption Charge, the Base Facility Charge and the Fire Service Monthly Rate were increased by 5% to fund operating expenses effective 10/1/07. 2008... On 1/24/08, the Board approved to increase the Wastewater Rates to cover expenses for wastewater operations with an effective date of 02/01/08. 5/2008... The Consumption Charge, the Base Facility Charge and the Fire Service Monthly Rate were increased by 5% to fund operating expenses effective 10/1/08. 10/2008... The Consumption Charge, the Base Facility Charge and the Fire Service Monthly Rate were increased by 5% to fund operating expenses effective 10/1/08. 5/2009... The Consumption Charge, the Base Facility Charge and the Fire Service Monthly Rate were automatically increased by the Water/Wastewater Rate Index adjustment formula (2.27%) effective 5/1/09. 7/25/09... The Board established the Wastewater Rates for the Big Coppit District to be effective 09/01/09. 9/17/09... The FKAA acquired the Key Haven Utility (wastewater) and as part of the acquisition assumed the Key Haven District wastewater rates.

Note:

In 2007, the South Florida Water Management District declared Mandatory Water Use Restrictions. Phase I was implemented on 3/22/07 and Phase II was implemented on 4/13/07; in compliance with FKAA Policy, the FKAA implemented a 15% Surcharge effective with the April, 2007 consumption and a 30% Surcharge effective with the May, 2007 consumption. The Surcharge was suspended from being billed on water bills in August, 2007 based on financial stability of the FKAA. In March, 2009, the Board approved an increase to the Tap Fee and Drop-In Fee for water. Effective July 1, 2009, the Board approved a revision to the method for calculation of the Water Restriction Surcharge (reducing the 4 Phase approach of 15%-60% and establishing only 1 Surcharge Phase charged at 15%)
