

## I. 15% Energy and Water Reduction Resources

Pursuant to the City's adopted Climate Action Plan reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 15% and to demonstrate sustainable community leadership, applicants must document 15% water and 15% energy use reductions on site. As a governmental entity the city is committed to being a responsible. By investing in sustainable projects the City will ensure greater lifecycle of redevelopment projects, healthier conditions for the occupants and the community as a whole, and the overall reduction of utility costs for the property owner.

- 1. An energy and water baseline report consisting of 12 months of energy and water use. For including multifamily structures, building data should be input into EPA Portfolio Manager (https://www.energystar.gov/istar/pmpam/), and provided to the City of Key West Sustainability Coordinator. For residential, either EnergyGuage or RESNET may be used to establish a baseline.
