

Recycling Update:

- Created *Plastic Free July* flyer for both print and digital use.
- Created Skip the Stuff guidelines in both Spanish and Haitian Creole.
- Collaborated with Monroe County, Islamorada, and the TDC to launch a Keys-wide Skip the Stuff campaign. Developed various outreach materials including flyers, placemats, table tents, and buttons.
- Recruited organizational support for the *Skip the Stuff* campaign; secured backing from 21 organizations.
- Conducted site visits to Key West businesses to encourage participation in the *Skip the Stuff campaign*.
- Requested removal of all recycling bins on Duval Street due to high contamination rates.
- Contacted St. Augustine Solid Waste Division to gather information on Big Belly bins.
- Delivered a composter to the Montessori school across the street.
- Designed Back to School flyer.
- Edited and submitted draft Waste and Recycling pages for the Special Events Application.

Sewer/Storm/GIS/Solid Waste:

- Conducted and/or attended monthly and bi-weekly meetings with Directors & Staff,
 Waste Management, OMI, Navy SBIR, Florida Commerce, and Monroe County.
- Generated quarterly reports for Community Development Block Grants.
- Attended the final review for acceptance of the S. Roosevelt Blvd Stormwater Pump Station.
- Prepared Annual Assessment Rates for adoption by the City Commission.
- Met with Monroe County staff on site at Government Road to survey the potential location of a new stormwater pump station.
- Met with OMI and Monroe County Health Department staff regarding beach sampling at South Beach; agreed to construct a "Healthy Beaches" sign.
- Billed the Navy for the annual solid waste assessments.
- Reviewed and planned for the I & I Sewer Project.
- Conducted a joint exercise with OMI simulating a sewer plant shutdown and the processes and procedures related to bringing the plant back online.
- Cleared major brush from the City's utility easement between Poinciana Trailer Park and Solana Village; gate was under construction.
- Substantially completed the Pump Station G Rehabilitation project; most punch list items were completed.
- Received the 100% design package for the Pump Station R Rehabilitation.
