A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BICYCLE FACILITIES FEATURES MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF KEY WEST" FOR MAINTENANCE OF "FINAL MILE" PROJECT BIKE PARKING FACILITIES ON FDOT RIGHT-OF-WAY (ALONG BUS ROUTES) WITHIN KEY WEST CITY LIMITS (FDOT LAP PROJECT 446126-1-58-01); AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has worked in coordination with Florida Dept of Transportation (FDOT) on the "Final Mile" project, which includes design and construction of Bike facilities (bike racks, bike lockers, bike fixit stations, bus shelter signs, etc.) along bus routes on state-controlled roadway within Key West City limits (SR-5 (US-1) (Overseas Highway)/North Roosevelt Blvd/Whitehead Street/Truman Ave/A1A/South Roosevelt Boulevard); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the FDOT LAP Agreement, the project includes bicycle, pedestrian and bus rider amenities that the City has the capacity and ability to maintain; and

WHEREAS, the amenities will improve and enhance safety and welfare for visitors and citizens of the City of Key West, and the City Commission finds it reasonable for the City to

execute an agreement to maintain the bicycle and pedestrian amenities, and certain associated costs of maintenance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby approves the attached "FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BICYCLE FACILITIES FEATURES MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF KEY WEST." (FDOT LAP project 446126-1-58-01)

Section 2: Yearly maintenance costs for the bicycle facilities features will be budgeted and paid from a maintenance fund created within the City's Transportation Alternatives Fund, (111-4903-549-4600), to begin in fiscal year 2023. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
