RE: Complaint Response

Mr. Engle,

I am Lieutenant Jeffrey Dean of the Key West Police Department's Internal Affairs Division. Your complaint was forwarded to me for review. Upon review of the reports associated with this case (attached), I have determined Officer Holmes, nor any other officer who responded to the scene, violated any KWPD policy or Florida statute.

As you can see in the attached dispatch records, your vehicle was reported prior to this law enforcement encounter, and a BOLO was sent out for your vehicle. Officer Holmes conducted a legal traffic stop and upon being detained during a lawful traffic stop, you are required to provide your driver's license and exit the vehicle if asked to do so. Your refusal to follow these lawful commands is probable cause to arrest for obstruction.

This response in no way is meant to indicate guilt or innocence, that is for the courts to decide.

This complaint has been reviewed and was determined to be UNFOUNDED. The Key West Police Department considers the matter to be closed.
