

1. City of Ocala, 1805 NE 30th Ave, Ocala, FL, 34470. Stacey Ferrante Water Resources Manager, 352-351-6772
 - a. Fiscal Year 2025 Manhole Rehabilitation Project. City of Ocala issued ESS \$850,000.00 Blanket purchase order to complete manhole rehabilitation. Utilizing ESS's Sarasota County Annual Manhole Rehabilitation Contract as a piggyback vehicle for pricing. Engineered Spray Solutions utilized SprayWall Polyurethane Liner as it is the preferred liner for the City of Ocala. We started work in February of 2025 and completed the work assignment of Lift Station basin 2 in April of 2025. This project consisted of mobilizing a two-truck, four-man, team to the city of Ocala. One truck is our box truck which is our self-contained spray apparatus including HVR reactor for material, supplied air, and electricity. The second truck is a support truck which carries all of the preparatory materials including traffic control needs, profiling mortar, chemical grout for water stopping, pressure washer for cleaning structures, patching material and other small tools. For the City of Ocala we spray 250 mils of SprayWall on most manhole structures and a Sprayroq Engineer Designed Strucutal amount to ensure that the liner will hold up under worst case scenarios. These designs take into consideration live loads, dead loads, and hydrostatic pressure along with degradation levels and geometry of the structure. A 4' diameter manhole that is 4' deep at the water's edge is very different than the 4' diameter manhole that is 25' deep, we account for the additional forces acting on the structure. Under this contract we were able to do roughly 115 manholes.
2. City of Melbourne, 2891 Harper Rd, Melbourne, FL 32904, Butch Burke, Wastewater Collections Foreman, 321-608-5172
 - a. Fiscal Year 2025 Manhole Rehabilitation Project. City of Ocala issued ESS \$1,000,000.00 Blanket purchase order to complete manhole rehabilitation. Utilizing ESS's Sarasota County Annual Manhole Rehabilitation Contract as a piggyback vehicle for pricing. Engineered Spray Solutions utilized Sewpercoat 100% pure fused Calcium Aluminate and SprayWall Polyurethane Liner as it is the preferred liners for the City of Melbourne. We started work in October of 2024 and completed the work assignment of Lift Station basin 2 in April of 2025. This project consisted of mobilizing a two-truck, four-man, team to the city of Ocala. One truck is our box truck which is our self-contained spray

apparatus including HVR reactor for material, supplied air, and electricity. The second truck is a support truck which carries all of the preparatory materials including traffic control needs, profiling mortar, chemical grout for water stopping, pressure washer for cleaning structures, patching material and other small tools. For the City of Melbourne we spray 250 mils of SprayWall or 1” of Sewpercoat on most manhole structures Under this contract we were able to do roughly 130 manholes.

3. Sarasota County, 1001 Sarasota Center Blvd, Steve Bothast, Construction Project Manager, 941-861-5000
 - a. Sarasota County Awarded Engineered Spray Solutions with a contract for bid #201918KW for Manhole & Structures rehabilitation. This was a 3-year annual contract initial term with 2 1-year renewals that ESS received both renewals on. Over the length of the Contract ESS completed \$1,115,734.00 worth of work. That totaled 17 lift stations and 112 manholes over the life of the contract. This contract was awarded utilizing SprayWall Polyurethane Liner. This project consisted of mobilizing one or multiple a two-truck, four-man, team to the Sarasota County. One truck is our box truck which is our self-contained spray apparatus including HVR reactor for material, supplied air, and electricity. The second truck is a support truck which carries all of the preparatory materials including traffic control needs, profiling mortar, chemical grout for water stopping, pressure washer for cleaning structures, patching material and other small tools. The County asks for 250 mils of Spraywall on manholes and 500 mils on lift stations.
4. City of Clearwater, 1650 N Arcturas Ave, Bldg A, Clearwater, FL 33765-1945, John Pacifici P.E. with Hazen and Sawyer Program Manager, 813-682-1217.
 - a. City of Clearwater has hired the consulting engineering firm Hazen and Sawyer to oversee their annual manhole rehabilitation program. Engineered Spray Solutions has had this contract in place since 2022. In FY 2025 Engineered Spray Solutions was given a spend authority of \$4,000,000.00 towards manhole rehabilitation. That authorized spend allowed us to complete roughly 700 manholes in fiscal year 2025. This contract required 2 full-time crews on site, with an additional crew or two to be added if there were times of inclement weather or other delays. These manholes specifically are coastal manholes and vary drastically from manhole to manhole and between time of day. Because of tidal influences infiltration is more sporadic than in other areas of the state and trying to waterproof via chemical grouting can be very tricky due to the soil being all sand. City of Clearwater prefers the SprayWall product at 250 mils. This program increased the spend authority to 6 million for FY 2026 and in turn ESS has increased crews. ESS is willing and able to staff up to accommodate any level of workload.
5. City of Orlando, 5420 L.B. McLeod Rd, Orlando, FL 32811, Keith Jordan, Conserv II W.R.F. Plant Manager, 407-246-4086

- a. City of Orlando Conserv II W.R.F. aeration basins were experiencing vertical cracking at various points along its concrete outer wall in 2024. Upon inspection of the tanks multiple defects were identified, cracks due to soil movement, degradation of joints, and concrete spalling. ESS utilized a two-man team in a specialized crack injection/spall repair outfitted truck. This truck has both hydrophobic and hydrophilic grouts. We utilize mostly flexible grouts when working on structures such as above ground aeration basins. We removed the existing joint seal, installed new backer rod, and installed new joint sealant. For the spalling concrete, we cleaned the area, chipped out all the damaged concrete down to good concrete, clean and applied rust inhibitor to any rebar that we encountered and applied new high strength concrete to the location. After curing we coated the concrete and grout. This specific project cost \$86,894.00 and we completed it within 6 weeks.

The City of Clearwater, FL has a successful multiple year working relationship with Engineered Spray Solutions (ESS) the Sprayroq Certified Partner for the State of Florida. And, from a City Engineer's prospective the Clearwater has benefited greatly by specifying the Sprayroq Polyurethane Structural Lining System for all our manhole and lift station rehabilitation requirements.

It is because of the professionalism, excellent communications and outstanding workmanship the City of Clearwater has entered into a three -year contract with ESS beginning on February 1st, 2019. The contract awarded to ESS is for the rehabilitation of approximately 330 of our city's beachside manholes and numerous deteriorated lift stations through the community.

At the end of each manhole lining ESS will perform an electronic holiday test on the interior wall of each structure to ensure a pinhole free monolithic lining.

Project Approach

Operations Plan and Project Management

Engineered Spray Solutions, LLC
City of Key West – RFP No. 26-004

1. Contract Management and Task Order Implementation

Engineered Spray Solutions, LLC (ESS) will provide the City of Key West with a structured, responsive, and highly coordinated approach to support the City's General Services for Manhole and Concrete Rehabilitation program. Our operational plan is designed to efficiently deliver rehabilitation services through the City's task order-based contract structure while maintaining strict compliance with City specifications, industry standards, and safety regulations.

Upon receipt of a task order, ESS will implement the following steps:

- Task Order Review – Evaluate scope, location, and schedule requirements; confirm quantities and applicable unit price items; identify site access considerations and operational constraints.
- Kickoff Coordination – Coordinate with the City's Utility Department and operations staff; establish sequencing for manhole isolation, flow control, and site access; confirm safety requirements, traffic control needs, and environmental considerations.
- Schedule Development – Prepare a construction schedule identifying project activities, sequencing, and submittal timelines for City approval.
- Mobilization – Assign field crews, equipment, and materials and implement traffic control and bypass pumping where required.

2. Operations Plan for Field Work

ESS maintains experienced crews specializing in sewer structure rehabilitation and protective lining systems. Our operations plan focuses on efficient field execution while maintaining the highest quality standards.

Inspection and Preparation activities include:

- Pre-rehabilitation inspection and documentation of structure condition
- Removal of debris, grease, roots, and mineral deposits
- High-pressure cleaning of structures
- Surface preparation to achieve required concrete profile
- Identification and sealing of infiltration points



Where necessary, ESS will implement bypass pumping or flow isolation to maintain uninterrupted sewer service during rehabilitation operations.

3. Structural Repairs

ESS crews will perform structural repairs required to restore the integrity of each structure, including:

- Chemical or mechanical grouting to stop infiltration
- Bench and invert reconstruction
- Chimney, joint, and grade ring repairs
- Installation of internal chimney seals or joint wraps
- Replacement of frames, covers, and steps when required

These repairs ensure the structure is properly stabilized prior to lining installation.

4. Spray-Applied Lining Installation

Once repairs are completed and surfaces properly prepared, ESS will apply the selected corrosion-resistant lining system.

The application process includes:

- Final surface preparation and moisture verification
- Installation of repair mortars or leveling layers where required
- Spray application of the monolithic protective coating system
- Achieving specified coating thickness and coverage
- Finishing benches and inverts to maintain proper flow channel

Spray application provides a continuous barrier that prevents infiltration and protects structures from hydrogen sulfide corrosion while extending the service life of the infrastructure.

5. Concrete Spalling and Structural Repair

For repairs performed at City facilities such as the wastewater treatment plant, ESS will execute vertical and overhead concrete rehabilitation including:

- Removal of deteriorated concrete
- Cleaning and protection of reinforcing steel
- Structural crack repair through epoxy injection or routing and sealing
- Installation of polymer-modified repair mortars
- Replacement of deteriorated sealant joints



All work will follow applicable ACI, ICRI, ASTM, and OSHA standards for structural concrete repair and worker safety.

6. Quality Control and Inspection

ESS maintains a comprehensive quality assurance program to ensure all work meets City specifications and industry standards.

Quality control measures include:

- Inspection of surface preparation and substrate condition
- Monitoring coating thickness during installation
- Adhesion testing of coatings
- Holiday detection testing
- Post-rehabilitation inspection and documentation

All work will be documented through daily field reports, photographic documentation, and final inspection reports provided to the City.

7. Safety and Environmental Compliance

Safety is integrated into every phase of ESS operations. Field crews operate in full compliance with OSHA confined space entry requirements, fall protection standards, and applicable traffic control regulations.

Safety measures include:

- Atmospheric monitoring
- Confined space entry procedures
- Personal protective equipment
- Traffic control and public protection systems

8. Communication and Reporting

ESS maintains consistent communication with the City throughout project execution. Our team will provide:

- Pre-task coordination meetings
- Daily field updates
- Immediate notification of unforeseen conditions
- Progress reporting as requested by the City
- Final documentation upon completion






