

RESOLUTION NO. 25-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD
OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING
PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-024 created the Sustainability Advisory Board to Advise and assist the City Commission in efforts to make City operations and the community as a whole more sustainable; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held June 9, 2025, the Sustainability Advisory Board finalized its annual priorities for fiscal year 2026; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Sustainability Advisory Board recommends the following priorities to the City Commission.

1) Increase Resiliency of Island

- i. Develop stronger building codes for wind and flood.
- ii. Implement Green Building Program
- iii. PR Efforts for Major Initiatives

2) Car Free Key West

- i. Create Exemplary eBike Program
- ii. Complete Citywide Comprehensive Safety Action Plan
- iii. Create a Pilot Roundabout along the Crosstown Greenway

3) Environmental Protection

- i. Decrease imperviousness by adopting BMPs for stormwater
- ii. Create new position to oversee the Water Quality Implementation Plan
- iii. Complete Tree Canopy Assessment Update

4) Waste Diversion

- i. Include Mandatory Single Use Plastic Ban in Leases and Special Event Language
- ii. Upgrade Trashbins near the ocean.

- iii. Outreach and Education with businesses, schools and throughout the community.
- iv. Update Solid Waste Master Plan

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and Clerk of the Sustainability Advisory Board.


