Marilyn/John Paul,

In order to move the ferry terminal pier design/permitting and the floating dock along Trumbo design/permitting there are two task that must be completed:

1. Soil boring data
2. Benthic Habitat Assessment

For Tarpon Pier design to move forward we need:

1. Soil boring data

Obviously these task come with cost and we have attempted to bundle them in with other projects to reduce overall cost. I need to make sure you have money budgeted for these or in the executive summaries for Bight Board and City Commission we need to authorize budget transfers from reserves. Here are the approximate cost:

1. KWBFT Soil Borings (2 holes): \$16,500
2. KWBFT and Floating Dock Benthic Habitat Assessment: \$19,154
3. Floating Docks Soil Borings (4 holes): \$29,000
4. Tarpon Pier Soil Borings (2 holes): \$16,500

The soil borings for the floating docks can also be used for the future finger piers. Please let me know what account numbers you want to use. We are shooting for Bight Board on Oct 19th and City Commission Nov 1
