to the Art in Public Places Board by Mayor Craig Cates.

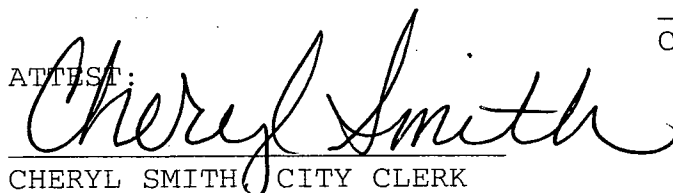
Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect
