RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 4 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BCC ENGINEERING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,267.45 FOR THE SOUTHERNMOST POINT PLAZA PROJECT TO ADJUST THE DESIGN TO A TRADITIONAL CURBED ROADWAY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission previously approved an agreement with BCC Engineering for the design of the Southernmost Point Plaza Project in the amount of \$291,135.94; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 was approved in the amount of \$35,425.63, bringing the total contract to \$326,561.57, as authorized by Resolution 24-155; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 2 resulted in a contract deduction of \$18,264.50, reducing the contract amount to \$308,297.07; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 3, \$15,166.58, authorized stormwater modeling for a traditional curbed roadway design, confirming that the curbed design can be achieved with minimal impact, no additional inlets, and no flooding under the 5-year, 24-hour design storm event; and

WHEREAS, City staff has continued discussions with

stakeholders, including residents and business owners, who expressed preference for a traditional curbed roadway that will also provide significant construction cost savings;

WHEREAS, funding for this change order is budgeted from Account 101-1900-519-6300 (Infrastructure Surtax), under Project IS19002401;

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 4 in the amount of \$45,267.45 is necessary to finalize the design adjustment to a traditional curbed roadway, bringing the total contract amount to \$368,731.10, which remains below the authorization of Resolution 25-4476.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission approves Change Order No. 4 to the agreement with BCC Engineering in the amount of \$45,267.45 for the Southernmost Point Plaza Project to adjust the roadway design to a traditional curbed roadway.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents consistent with this Resolution, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the

Commission.
