- WHEREAS, Canon John H. Reece, Jr. became the rector of St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Key West, Fl in 1950, and remained until 1975; and
- WHEREAS, during the 25 years in Key West, he left an indelible mark on the parishioners as well as the citizens of the city; and
- WHEREAS, he was fondly known as Father Reece and was respected as a dedicated priest, community leader and mentor; and
- WHEREAS, Father Reece was extremely effective with the youth of the church and community, working diligently with the Sunday School, acolytes, youth choir and summer school students; and
- WHEREAS, he strongly believed in education, therefore, he took it upon himself and at his own expense, to establish a "summer school" for children in the community. As the only instructor, he broadened their educational experiences and supplemented their education in the basic subjects.
