A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RATIFYING AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-797(1), 2-797(2), AND 2-797(4) (b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER, EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT, AND IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY, FOR DOUBLE DISK GATE VALVES (2), BUTTERFLY VALVES WITH ROTORK ACTUATORS (2), AND AIR/VACUUM RELEASE VALVES (2), FROM PSI TECHNOLOGIES, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$122,650.00; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West owns, operates, and maintains two injection wells, IW-1 and IW-2, at the Richard A Heyman Environmental Protection Facility, and immediate replacement of the valves on the wellheads is required; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of Crispin Valve manufactured double disk gate valves (2), butterfly valves with Rotork actuators (2), and air/vacuum release valves (2), pursuant to sole source provider, emergency procurement, and in the best interests of the city specification provisions of the City of Key West Code of Ordinances, Sections 2-797(10), 2-797(2), and 2-797(4) (b), is permitted; and

WHEREAS, three vendors, suppliers of industrial valves, were

contacted with a request to provide quotes for gate valves, butterfly valves with Rotork actuators, and air/vacuum release valves. Only one vendor, PSI Technologies, Inc., was responsive and provided pricing for the valves, as requested; and

WHEREAS, City staff has determined Crispin Valves are a sole source product in this region, sold exclusively through PSI Technologies, Inc., pursuant to Section 2-797(1) (b) of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager finds that exceptional circumstances exist to exempt this purchase of gate valves, butterfly valves with Rotork actuators, and air/vacuum release valves from competitive bid requirements in the best interests of the City, based on immediate requirement to replace the inoperative valves, pursuant to Section 2-797(4) (b) of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-797(2) of the City's Code of Ordinances requires the City Commission to ratify such emergency procurements at its next scheduled meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the emergency procurement of Crispin Valve manufactured double disk gate valves (2), butterfly valves with Rotork actuators (2), and air/vacuum release valves (2) on sole source provider, emergency procurement, and best interests of the city, pursuant to Code of Ordinances Section 2-797(1), Section 2-797(2), and Section 2-797(4)(b), from PSI Technologies, Inc., in the amount of \$122,650.00, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this purchase is funded through Sewer Fund, Construction in Progress, account number 401-3504-535-6500, for Project Number SE35042301 Deep Well Valve Replacement, in the amount of \$200,000.

Section 3: Budget transfer from Account 401-3501-535-9900 Other Uses to account 401-3504-535-6500 Construction in Progress is hereby approved.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
