
Dear Messrs. Scholl & Finigan:



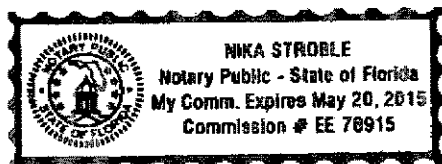
