A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDED THE BID OF LIFETIME DOCK & LUMBER IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #13-022 FOR KEY WEST BIGHT FERRY TERMINAL BOAT LIFTS FOR USE BY THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$31,491.00; APPROVING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Lifetime Dock & Lumber in response to ITB #13-022 is hereby awarded in the amount of \$31,491.00 for Key West Bight Ferry Terminal Boat Lifts for use by the Police Department.

Section 2: That necessary budget transfers are authorized to project account #101-2101-521.64/PD1406 and from grant revenue account #101-000-331-.20/PD1406, along with forfeiture funds. (Up to 75% of project cost will be reimbursed from a Department of Homeland Security Grant, approved in Resolution 12-314, the City match will be provided from forfeiture funds).

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the contract documents contained within the bid package on behalf of the City of Key West upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
