- Staples Ave & 4th St Construction underway. Final pavement markings anticipated November.
- Southernmost Point Plaza Construction underway. Reverted to traditional curbed roadway.
- North Roosevelt Blvd RRR (446011-1)(446011-2) Construction underway. Safety Improvements still programmed..
- US1 and East College Rd Signalization (449756-1-52-01) Construction est. 2026. Allows for easier bus turning movements and includes roadway bicycle detection. Letting in Sept.
- Von Phister Safety Improvements (456901-1-54-01) FY26 construction. Grant approval 10/2025
- Flagler Ave Resiliency Monroe County, 30% design. Incorporating complete streets features and improved bicycle facilities

October Sustainable Transportation Update

• Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants

- The Key West Safety Action Plan will be completed by early 2026
 - Promoting the safety issue map https://ufl.maps.arcgis.com/apps/webappviewer/index.html?id=4af89680a42540589e99e 120451c4bd8
 - E-bike survey results from 11 Task Force members ranked 13 initiatives on a scale of 1 to 5
 - 4.6 Improve sidewalk infrastructure
 - 4.3 Traffic gardens
 - 4.3 Ban class 2 (throttle only) and class 3 (29 MPH) e-bikes on all sidewalks
 - 4.1 Age limits on e-bike usage
 - 4.0 Educate the community about e-bike safety
- Florida law went into effect on July 1, 2025
 - Working with Multimodal Transportation Coordinator on a Letter to the Commission
 - E-bike amendment to Senate Bill 462 allows Key West to do e-bike enforcement on sidewalks along N Roosevelt Blvd
 - SB 462 permits local jurisdictions to require anyone who rides a bike to carry a photo ID and set an age registration
- o Partnering with City of Marathon and Village of Islamorada on SS4A
- Preparing to apply for FDOT's Transportation Alternative funding, which is due December 4,
 2025

Transit

- Researching short- and long-term innovative transit funding ideas
 - Applied for USDOT's Innovative Finance and Asset Concession (IFAC) Program grant
 - Requesting approval to purchase Via's Remix software, which will help with transit planning and scheduling
- Verifying bus stops in the field using the Automated Transit Stop Inventory Management (ATSIM) system

- Plan to work with Multimodal Transportation Coordinator to discuss with local bike rental companies about launching a bikeshare program
- Plan to purchase bus bike racks compatible with beach cruisers and e-bikes
