



In the early morning hours of Monday, June 10, 2017 in the City of Key West, Florida, a citizen witnessed an incident between two men wherein one of the men mentioned an assault weapon that he was carrying, during the argument with the other individual.

The citizen immediately reported what he had heard to a police officer who in turn broadcasted the information over police radio to all police units advising them to be on the lookout for a man riding a yellow scooter on Duval Street carrying a large guitar case because he might be armed and dangerous.

Within minutes the subject was detained. The officers found and recovered an AR 15 assault rifle, and a 9mm Glock pistol, several fast loading ammunition clips for each firearm and over 200 rounds of live ammunition.

The driver was arrested and weapons confiscated removing a potential threat from our community. All this was made possible because one citizen "WHO HAD SEEN SOMETHING---SAID SOMETHING" a good example of the importance of ordinary citizens helping to keep our community safe.
