On 12-25-2018, at approximately 0045 hours, Officer T. Calvert and I (Officer T. Getchel) responded to 1300 15th Court. #70 in reference to a 911 call about an unknown problem with a woman caller and someone screaming in the background.

Upon arrival, I noticed two women on the front porch. One woman went inside the house as we walked up. The other woman, later identified as Taylor Marie Lozada, was sitting in a chair on the front porch with her arms folded. Officer Calvert asked Lozada why we were there and she replied that we were here for nothing "obviously". The front door was ajar and Officer Calvert reached out to open the door. Lozada got out of her chair and blocked the door saying "no no no, you can not go in". Lozada pushed the door closed with one arm and pushed Officer Calvert with the other. Officer Calvert took control of Lozada's right arm and brought her to the ground. Officer Calvert told her to stay put while I watched her so that he could check on the occupants of the trailer. Officer Leahy placed Lozada in handcuffs, moments later for resisting.

An investigation into the 911 call revealed that there was a domestic disturbance between Harold Wayne Martin, Kelly Marie Ray and Lozada. Martin and Lozada have a 4 YOA daughter together and Ray is the grandmother of the child and mother of Martin. When I talked with Ray, she told me that there had been a domestic between her son and Lozada. When I tried to inquire further Ray would not provide any specific details. Martin said that there was an argument over the presents but also would not elaborate. Lozada said they were having an argument over the presents and the confrontation escalated when she decided to take the presents she had purchased for her daughter and leave the home with them. Lozada had said that the confrontation did become physical when she was trying leave with the presents. Lozada said she had called a friend to pick her up. Martin came outside and began to put the presents into his truck. Lozada said that she tried to take the presents out of Martin's truck and Martin tried to put his arm around her neck. Lozada told us this as we were arriving at the jail. None of the people involved had any physical indications of being in a physical altercation. None of the people involved wanted any further police involvement.

Sgt. Rodriguez was notified by Officer Calvert that he had responded to resistance offered by Lozada. Sgt Rodriguez responded to the scene and spoke with Lozada. My BWC was activated during this encounter.

I charged Lozada with resisting officer without violence, a violation of F.S.S. 843.02. Lozada did obstruct Officer Calvert's ability to investigate a 911 emergency call for help.
