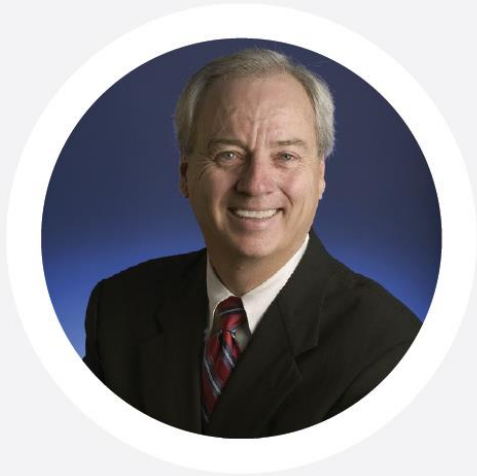

Recent: February 28, 2023	U.S. Department of Transportation – Rebuilding America’s Infrastructure Sustainability and Equity (RAISE)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Capital or Planning projects for surface transportation that will have significant local or regional impact. - Award floor \$5 million urban area, \$1m rural/ \$25 million ceiling - No match for Rural applicants (KW is Rural) - Award Announcements – June 28, 2023 (~4 months after deadline) - Period of Performance - RAISE grant performance is until Sept. 30, 2027, BIL funds must be expended by Sept. 20, 2032.
