WHEREAS, the "One Human Family" campaign was launched in 2000 by local artist J.T. Thompson as an effort to promote peace, tolerance and to embrace the diversity of Key West and the world beyond; and

WHEREAS, in the years since, more than a million "One Human Family" stickers have been distributed globally, and the simple motto has become an international grassroots campaign to unite all people and to promote equal rights, dignity and respect;

WHEREAS, on October 17th, 2000, the City Commission proclaimed that "One Human Family" is now "the official philosophy of our beloved City of Key West, and that we all freely share our official philosophy with all our fellow humans; each of us striving to be a shining example of that simple motto in our daily lives, from this day forward;" and

WHEREAS, on the 10th anniversary of "One Human Family," the City Commission sees fit to celebrate the origins of that simple motto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
