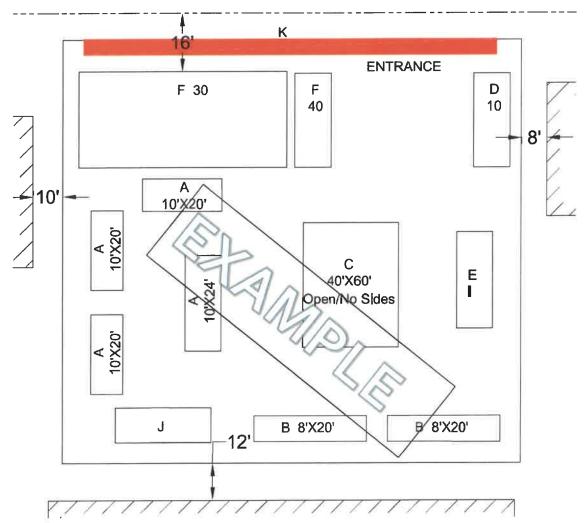

Route- starts at Mary Ellen's on Appelrouth lane.

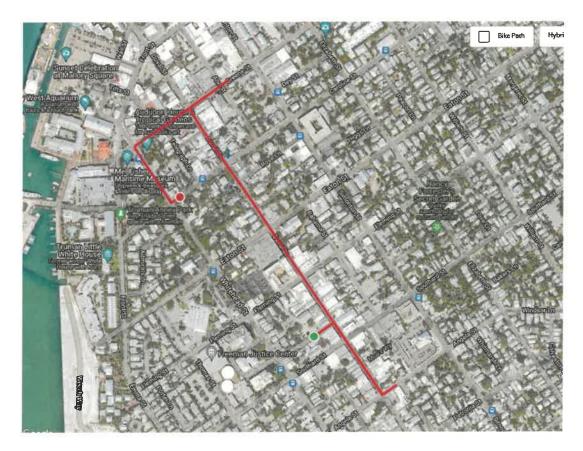
