An application was received for the removal of **one (1) Strangler Fig tree**. A site inspection was done on November 27, 2012 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Strangler Fig (Ficus aurea)





Diameter: **60 inches dbh**

Location: 40% - Foundation issues

Species: 100% - On protected tree list

Condition: 60% - Fair health

Total Average Value = 67%

Value x Diameter = replacement caliper (dbh) inches

.67 x 60" dbh = **40 replacement caliper (dbh) inches**

Recommendations: **Staff recommends approval of the removal.**

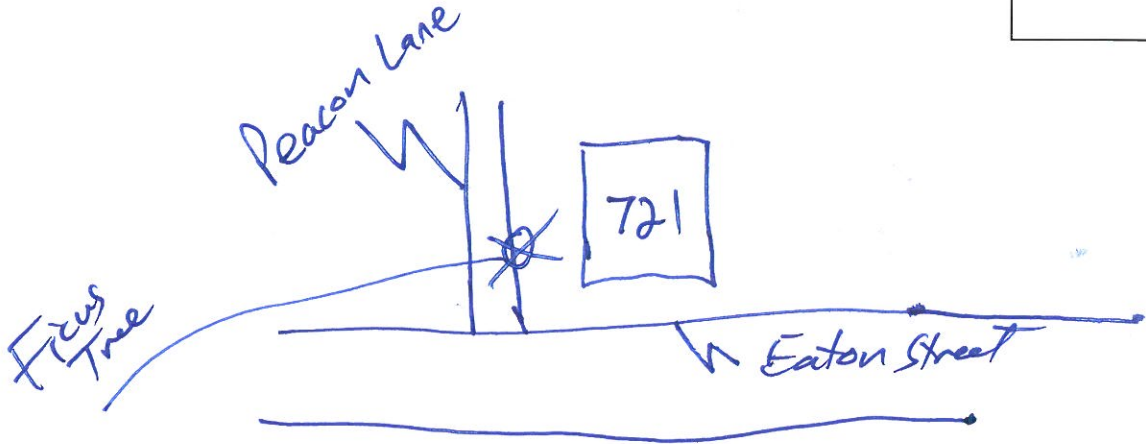
