TROPICAL STORM/HURRICANE PARKING AGREEMENT		
This <b>TROPICAL STORM/HURRICANE PARKING AGREEMENT</b> (" <b>Agreement</b> ") is made and entered into as of this day of, 2011 by and between Utility Board of the City of Key West, Florida (" <b>KEYS</b> ") and the City of Key West, Florida (the CITY) concerning use of the Park N Ride Facility owned by the City.		
RECITALS		
WHEREAS, KEYS (formerly d/b/a City Electric System) and the CITY entered into a LEASE AGREEMENT on the 13 <sup>th</sup> of October 1993 for a period of 30 years commencing the 1 <sup>st</sup> day of January, 1994 and ending on the 31 <sup>st</sup> day of December 2023; and		
WHEREAS, Said Lease Agreement provided KEYS with use of fifty (50) ground floor dedicated parking spaces for the sole use by KEYS employees free of charge; and		
WHEREAS, Said Lease Agreement offers no provisions for parking KEYS owned vehicles nor KEYS employees' personal vehicles during Tropical Storm or Hurricane events when the possibility of flooding exists; and		
WHEREAS, the CITY and KEYS wish to protect the investment of public funds in KEYS owned vehicles.		
NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, undertakings, and other consideration set forth in this Agreement, KEYS and the City agree as follows:		
1. Permission to Park. CITY agrees to provide KEYS with twenty-one (21) parking places in the upper floors of the Park N Ride in order to protect the vehicles from rising water. Said vehicles will be KEYS owned vehicles with "City" license plates and "KEYS" logos. Said vehicles will be SUVs, pickup trucks or cars. Parking will be provided at no cost to KEYS. Parking may commence when a Tropical Storm/Hurricane Watch is issued.		
2. KEYS Responsibility. KEYS will be responsible for parking all vehicles on the upper deck of the Park N Ride and removing all vehicles from the Park N Ride within twenty-four (24) hours after the storm has passed. KEYS will ensure that all trucks have been cleared of loose material in the beds. The vehicles will be secured and locked.		
3. Use for Privately Owned Vehicles (POV's). CITY acknowledges that some KEYS personnel are required to work during a Tropical Storm/Hurricane Event. CITY will accommodate up to seven (7) POV's at no cost for KEYS Employees who are working during the Event. KEYS will provide a list of names to the Parking Attendant when a Tropical Storm/Hurricane Watch is issued. KEYS acknowledges that the CITY may refuse these POV's if other public, governmental vehicles need a place of refuge. Employees will park on the upper deck and will clear vehicle of any loose material in the beds.		
The parties have signed this Agreement as of the Effective Date.
