A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PINCHERS CRAB SHACK AT 712 DUVAL STREET FOR AN EVENT TO TAKE PLACE DURING THE HOURS OF 7:00 P.M. TO 3:00 A.M. ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2014 AND WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2014; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Pinchers Crab Shack has applied to the City for a Special Event Permit for "Pink Bras & Claws" on Tuesday, October 21 starting at 7:00 p.m. and ending on Wednesday, October 22nd at 3:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, this event shall take place on the grounds of Pinchers Crab Shack at 712 Duval Street; and

WHEREAS, amplified music will be played during the event;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

SECTION 1. That Pinchers Crab Shack is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the place and time as herein described.

SECTION 2. That Pinchers Crab Shack will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and

adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
