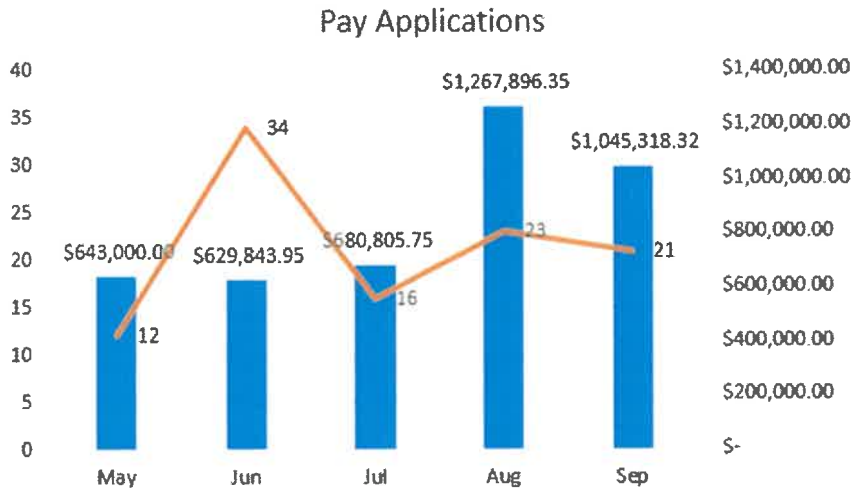

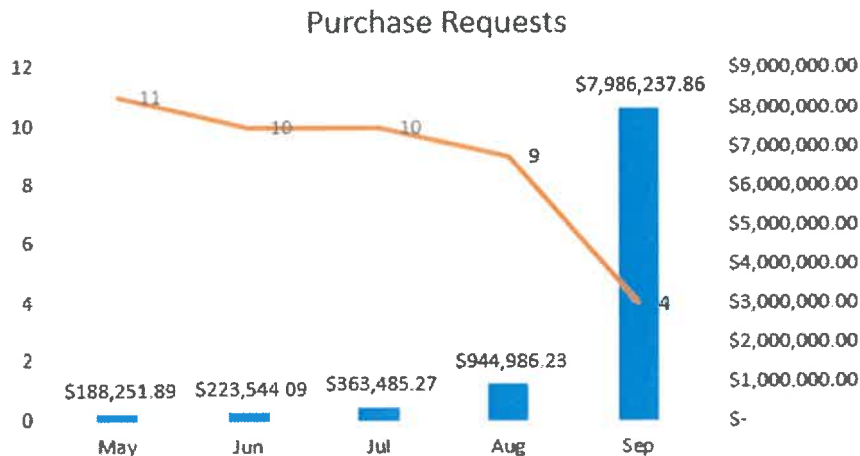

There were 21 pay applications worth \$1,04,318 in September.
