## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING OHWOOK! PRODUCTIONS, INC. TO CONDUCT A "MILE O FEST KEY WEST - DUVAL STREET KICK OFF PARTY" FREE CONCERT ON THE 200 BLOCK OF DUVAL STREET FROM 5:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M. ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 27, 2026 (SETUP AT 6:00 A.M.); GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, OhWook! Productions, Inc. has applied to the city for a Special Event Permit for their event "Mile O Fest Key West - Duval Street Kick Off Party" to take place on Tuesday, January 27, 2026, from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, OhWook! Productions, Inc. will be closing the 200 block of Duval Street, with a stage setup at the intersection of Duval Street and Greene Street; and

WHEREAS, amplified music will be played during the event until 10:00 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 1.}}$  That In Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the

use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.

SECTION 3. That OhWook! Productions, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance.

Section 5. There will be live amplified music during the event Page 2 of 4

until 10:00 p.m.

SECTION 6. That OhWook! Productions, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That OhWook! Productions, Inc. acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
