A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING RISING HIGH REGGAE ON THE ROCK, BAHAMAS RELIEF FUND, INC TO CONDUCT A FUNDRAISER FOR THE BAHAMAS ON SUNDAY, MARCH 8, 2020 FROM 2:30 P.M. TO 11:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF GREENE STREET FROM DUVAL STREET TO ANN STREET DURING THE EVENT; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCES PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 2:30 P.M. TO 11:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, permission is hereby granted to Rising High Reggae on the Rock, Bahamas Relief Fund, Inc. for a Bahama Relief Fundraiser on Sunday, March 8, 2020..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use or distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic

items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City”

SECTION 3. That permission is hereby granted to Rising High Reggae on the Rock, Bahamas Relief Fund, Inc. for the Bahama Relief Fundraiser on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That other bars participating in the liquor extension are The Green Room, Sandbar Sports & Grill, Paradise Pizza & Ice Cream & Tattoos & Scars Saloon.

SECTION 5. That Rising High! Reggae on the Rock, Bahama Relief Fund, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 6. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

SECTION 7. That Rising High! Reggae on the Rock, Bahama Relief Fund, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 8. That the Event organizers will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that

they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 9. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
