A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) FORD F250 REGULAR CAB PICKUP TRUCK FROM ALAN JAY FORD LINCOLN, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$21,724.00; AUTHORIZING A NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, this purchase is made pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances, under the annual Florida Sheriff's Association Bid; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of one (1) Ford F250 Regular Cab Pickup vehicle, pursuant to the attached proposal of Alan Jay Ford Lincoln in the total amount of \$21,724.00 is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That a necessary budget transfer within fund 405-7501-575-6400 is hereby authorized in the amount of \$3,724.00, to cover the difference between the \$18,000.00 budgeted for a truck purchase in FY 14-15 and the actual price quote of \$21,724.00.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
