A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATING MIAMI UASI (URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE) GRANT 2011 AGENCY" PURSUANT TO A FEDERALLY FUNDED SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (USDHS) AND THE MIAMI AND FORT LAUDERDALE URBAN AREA FOR THE MIAMI UASI GRANT PROGRAM FY 2011, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000.00, TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT, SERVICES AND ALLOWABLE PERSONNEL COSTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORT OF THE UASI PROJECT ADMINISTERED BY THE CITY OF MIAMI DEPARTMENT OF FIRE-RESCUE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management has allocated funds from the Department of Homeland Security for the Miami and Ft. Lauderdale area, including Key West, through the FY 2011 UASI Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West, as a participating agency, anticipates the award of \$15,000.00 to purchase equipment, services and allowable personnel costs in connection with the development and support of the UASI Project administered by the City of Miami Department of Fire-Rescue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Memorandum of Agreement For Participating Miami UASI Grant 2011 Agency" is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute the necessary documents to enact this Agreement, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
