An application was received for the removal of one (1) Royal Poinciana Tree. A site inspection was done on February 29, 2012 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Royal Poinciana (*Delonix regia*)



Diameter: 22.5" dbh

Location: 60% - in fence area

Species: 100% - Specially protected tree

Condition: 60% - tree is only in fair health

Total Average Value = 73.3%

Value x Diameter = replacement caliper (dbh) inches

.733 x 22.5" = **16.5" replacement caliper (dbh) inches**

Recommendations: Staff recommends approval of the permit – tree has large heavy co-dominant leaders that could split and fall on adjacent houses.
