 Attended Recycle Florida Today Conference Contamination from the consumer greatest obstacle to recycling efforts, clean recyclables have a greater value. Gained insight as to how other communities are managing recycling efforts. New Pembroke Pines (where KW recycling is transported) recycling facility expecting to open spring of 2025. New facility will be able to process difficult to market plastics, specifically plastic bags and films (plastics that can be torn/punctured with hands). Need to debunk myths that there are not markets for recyclables in the US. Issue is US generates dirty recyclables which reduces the value.
