WHEREAS, Arbor Day is nationally recognized on the last Friday in April and is annually observed throughout the nation and world to celebrate the role of trees in our lives and promote tree planting and care; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West recognizes the importance of trees and its environment and has been a member of Tree City USA for 11 years; and

WHEREAS, the not-for-profit organization, Coastlove, whose mission is to end ocean plastic and coastal degradation through action and education while empowering coastal communities to create change; and

WHEREAS, in September 2022, the southern shoreline and dune area of the Key West Nature Preserve beach access area was heavily damaged by Hurricane Ian; and


