## Fire Department

- 537 total Fire / EMS calls for service for the month of June 2023
  - 390 EMS calls.
  - 16 Motor vehicle accidents with injuries.
  - 6 Motor vehicle accidents without injuries.
  - 9 Motor vehicle accidents with pedestrians
  - 7 Elevator extrication.
  - 0 EMS calls to Sunset Key
  - 109 Fire calls for service.
- 268 total Fire Inspections conducted by the Fire Marshal's office for the month of June 2023.
  - 244 Fire safety inspections. (Businesses and Transient rentals)
  - 24 Fire safety plans review.
- June 1<sup>st</sup> the City Emergency Manager Greg Barroso briefed the City Manager on Hurricane Season Emergency Operations.
- June 1<sup>st</sup> Introduced the City Manager to the National Weather Stations NOAA Meteorologist Kennard "Chip" Kasper and Meteorologist John Rizzo and toured the NWS Key West facility.
- June 5<sup>th</sup> Meet with Tidal Basin Representatives Mr. Robert Bob Wright and Mr. Bill Slater. We discussed setting a meeting with City Directors for July to go over FEMA updates and forms for hurricane recovery. Also discussed Tidal Basins Staff to help with updating the City's CEMP.
- June 6<sup>th</sup> the City Emergency Manager Greg Barroso notified the City Manager that condition 4 has been set for City of Key West Directors. This condition 4 is from June 1<sup>st</sup> – November 30 and each City Department Director has discussed their department's hurricane season plans with their staff.
- Our EOC Command Staff is monitoring for any weather event, and I will inform you of any weather events that will change this status.
- June 5<sup>th</sup> KWFD hosted a Hazardous Materials Technicians 160 hours course.
