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On 03/06/19 at 9:30 AM, Ofc. G. Kouri and I, Ofc. Sellers, conducted a check for illegal campers along Government Rd. in the area designated the Key West Nature Preserve. We did encounter a male squatting by a tent our in the woods of said preserve, who was squatting in front of a tent and surrounded with cooking and camping gear. We were dressed in full police uniform and explained to the male that he was in violation of a city ordinance prohibiting his camping in said area. I requested identification from the male explaining I intended to document a warning for the violation. The male claimed he was not in possession of any identification. He provided his name as "Roger Williams" and his date of birth as 06/04/69. He was wearing an army fatigue shirt with unit patches and claimed he was an Army veteran. I asked him what state he most recently had an ID or drivers license in and he said Hawaii. He spoke with no particular accent, but I caught one work that sounded like a Massachusetts accent. I asked him about this and he claimed to be from that state originally. I had dispatch check his name and date of birth through Hawaii, Massachusetts, and eventually Georgia and Arizona; however, no record for him could be found. When I asked him his social security number, he claimed not to remember it. I pointed out that this was very unusual taking into account his alleged military service. I asked if he had any weapons and he said he had a knife. He explained it was in his pants' pocket and I instructed him to remove it, without opening it, and I secured it from him. As we were conversing, I noticed his backpack, a few feet away, was unzipped a few inches. I saw what I believed, in my training and experience as a law enforcement officer and hunter, to be the orange and gray handle of an edged weapon. I went around and retrieved an approximately 1 1/2 foot long Gerber machete/chopping tool. He claimed he did not consider this a weapon, but I explained to him that it was not only a concealed weapon, but that he had concealed from me the fact that he possessed it. In my over two decades of law enforcement experience, I have never encountered someone of his apparent age, especially a veteran, who has not had any identification on record. I requested additional back-up officer(s) to come and assist. At this point, I believed he was concealing his true identity and instructed him to sit on the ground. He hesitated, but complied. Officers Andruzzi and Betz arrived to assist. Ofc. Betz explained that he was requesting an officer to come and scan the male's fingerprints in an effort to identify him. The male still claimed to be Roger Williams numerous times. Ofc. Alex Rodriguez arrived with the fingerprint scanner as I was going to my patrol car to secure the weapons and further research this alleged name and date of birth via my in-car computer. I secured the weapons, but was advised via radio to return to the campsite, as the male had produced his identification. He had it hidden under a bunch of "baby wipes" in a small compartment on the bottom of his backpack. I returned to the campsite and was provided Massachusetts driver license #S78098201, identifying the male as Donald D. Myotte D.O.B. 10/18/68. I provided this information to dispatch and advised them to run the new information via F/NCIC.

At this point I advised Myotte he was under arrest. I commanded him to place his hands behind his back and remain seated on the ground. I took my handcuffs out, but Myotte did not comply and instead pushed up off the ground and began to stand up. I grabbed the back of his shirt as he stood (I could not reach his arms). He spun around, swung his right arm towards me grabbing my left shoulder and tried to kick me with his right knee. He also raised his left arm towards me. I continued to grasp ahold of his shirt with my left hand, blocked his left hand with my right arm and raised my left knee to block his knee strike. At that point, Ofc. Rodriguez deployed his Taser. Hearing this, I released Myotte and he went to the ground. At least one prong of the taser had connected and a full cycle was delivered. Once on the ground, Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Andruzzi began attempting to handcuff Myotte. He was given loud verbal commands to put his hands behind his back, but he did not comply. They were able to get his right hand out from under him, but he refused to bring his left hand out from under his body. During this time, Myotte was physically pulling his right hand away. I handed Ofc. Betz my handcuffs and we all physically pulled his wrists into handcuffing position behind his back. While we were doing this, Myotte, put his mouth on Ofc. Andruzzi's knee and tried to bite him more than once. Ofc. Betz delivered knee strikes in an effort to get him to stop his physical resistance and overt attempts to injure Ofc. Andruzzi (who told him to stop biting him). Ofc. Betz was able to secure

him in handcuffs and I double locked them. We took him to my police car and placed him inside.

Dispatch advised Myotte had an active felony fugitive warrant out of Haverhill, MA for two counts of sexual assault on a disabled person. I read Myotte his Miranda warning enroute to the jail. He agreed to talk to me without and attorney present. When we got to the jail, Myotte asked me what I had found. I told him he had a warrant. I told him he probably already knew that and he said, "Yes." I told him he also probably knew it was out of Massachusetts and he said, "Yes." I asked him if he knew what it was for and he said, "sexual assault." Myotte therefore had knowledge of the warrant and had attempted to obstruct us in arresting him for said warrant by first providing a false identity and then resisting arrest both passively and physically. I completed an arrest affidavit charging Myotte with inhabiting the wetlands, carrying a concealed weapon, and resisting arrest with and without violence. Ofc. G. Kouri completed the report and affidavit for the fugitive warrant (KWPD case # 19-1495)

The encounter, arrest, and transport are recorded on officer's body worn cameras, my in-car Coban system, and Ofc. Rodriquez's Taser camera. The videos and the machette were placed into evidence. Detective Sgt. Andrea Fogarty, of the Haverhill Police Department, called to speak with me about the the circumstances of the arrest. She told me they had been tracking Myotte since the warrant was issued, but lost track of him in Maryland. I told her he had admitted knowledge of the warrant and that it was for sexual assault. I also advised her Myotte had in his possession a journal he had been writing in that may contain admissions or evidence in her case. This journal will accompany his backpack, which will be shipped with him to Massachusetts. She requested copies of our arrest paperwork and reports, which request I will forward via chain of command. I took photos of Myotte's back and a close-up of the tiny red mark where the lower, and evidently only, Taser probe entered his skin. I forwarded the photoraphs to the shift Sgt. and uploaded them as evidence under this case.

On Wednesday, March 6, 2019 at approximately 1007 hours, I (Ofc. A. Rodriguez) was working a FDOT funded motorcycle safety and enforcement grant. Ofc. F. Betz asked over Key West Dispatch Channel One for a unit that had a fingerprint scanner.

I advised I have one and would be enroute to his location, a small campsite just off of Government Road. Ofc. B. Sellers, Ofc. G. Kouri, and Ofc. M. Andruzzi were also on scene.

Upon arrival, I met with Ofc. B. Sellers who was walking out of the campsite with a machete. Ofc. B. Sellers advised me she retrieved the item from the unidentified subject's backpack.

I heard Ofc. G. Kouri state over Key West Dispatch Channel One that the male subject now provided a driver's license. I continued through the trail and met with the other officers and ran the subject's information through my in car computer. The subject was identified as Donald D. Myotte via his Massachusetts driver's license.

Ofc. B. Sellers returned and informed the male to place his hands behind his back as he previously provided a false name. I retrieved my TASER and turned it on. Myotte failed to follow the order to stay seated and place his hands behind his back, stood up, turned towards Ofc. B. Sellers and attempted to grab her person. I fired my TASER and achieved NMI (neuro-muscular incapacitation) via the probes that struck Myotte's back approximately eight to ten inches apart.

Myotte fell to the ground and continued to resist the numerous officers' commands to place his hands behind his back. I saw Ofc. F. Betz deliver two knee strikes to Myotte's right thigh in the area of the common peroneal. I attempted to deliver a second cycle from my TASER but did not achieve NMI. I did not attempt to drive stun Myotte as the TASER wires were now loose and I did not want to inadvertently shock an officer. Ofc. M. Andruzzi and Ofc. F. Betz were able to place Myotte into handcuffs.

I removed the probes from Myotte.

On 3/6/2019, at approximately 0950 hours, I (Ofc Betz), responded to Government Rd as backup for Ofc Sellers and Ofc G Kouri, who were out with a white male illegally camping.

Ofc Andruzzi was already on scene with the three when I arrived. I observed Ofc Sellers trying to identify the individual, who was later identified as Donald Myotte. Myotte had given Ofc Sellers a false name and date of birth. Myotte was also unsure of his identifying information, which he should have known and showed signs of nervousness.

I explained to Myotte that he could be charged with a false name. I added that I would have an officer respond to check his fingerprint to identify him. I gave him until the officer arrived to provide the correct name or he would be charged.

I called for Ofc Rodriguez, who was working an off-duty detail, to respond. Ofc Rodriguez, who was equipped with Rapid ID system, responded to the location. Myotte provided me with an Massachusetts ID card as Ofc Rodriguez arrived. I handed the ID to Ofc G Kouri to run.

Ofc Sellers, who had left to check for Myotte's information on her in-car computer, returned with Ofc Rodriguez. Ofc Sellers advised Myotte he was going to be placed under arrest for the camping violation and for providing a false name. Ofc Sellers told Myotte to stand and face away from her. As Myotte stood, he immediately turned and tried to grab Ofc Sellers. Ofc Rodriguez immediately used his Taser on Myotte.

Myotte fell to the ground. Ofc Andruzzi and I tried to get Myotte into handcuffs. Myotte kept reaching his hand underneath him. I gave two knee spikes to Myotte's right thigh area. I heard Ofc Andruzzi yell to Myotte, "Don't bite me." I looked over and saw Myotte's face next to Ofc Andruzzi's leg.

Ofc Andruzzi and I placed Myotte into handcuffs.

KWPD Dispatch later advised Myotte had an active warrant. My involvement was recorded on my BWC.

I, Officer Andruzzi, responded to a call to assist Officer Sellers regarding a camping violation in the sanctuary on Government Road.

As Officer Sellers attempted to place the suspect under arrest the suspect immediately started to resist Officer Sellers. The suspect was tased and was brought to the ground.

The suspect resisted to be handcuffed by tightening his arms and placing his hands under his body. Officer Betz continued to give him verbal direction to place his hands behind his back. From a kneeling position I assisted Officer Betz gain control of the suspects arms. As I was kneeling next to the suspects head/face area the suspect attempted to bite my right knee/leg. Officer Betz and I successfully handcuffed the suspect`s wrists behind his back.

The suspect was placed transported to Monroe County Jail for processing.

On March 6th, 2019, Ofc. Sellers and I (Ofc. G Kouri), were on foot patrol on Government Road Nature Preserve, (2171 Government Road, Key West, FL).

While on foot patrol, Ofc. Sellers and I, came across a camp site. As we approached the camp site, we made contact with a white male wearing a military jacket, cargo shorts and black combat boots. We told the male why we were there and asked him if he had any weapons on him. The male told us he had a knife in his pocket and gave it to us upon request. We asked the male what his name was and he told us his name was Roger Williams, with a date of birth of 06/04/1969. We asked the subject to sit down as an officer safety precaution. Ofc. Sellers ran the male by the name and date of birth that he gave us, however, dispatch could not get a return. We asked the subject for his social security number, so we could run him by that. The subject told us he was prior military and had a TBI (traumatic brain injury), and that's the reason he doesn't remember what his social security number is. Ofc. Sellers asked for another unit to respond as back up. Ofc. Andruzzi and Ofc. Betz responded to our location.

Ofc. Sellers found a machete inside of the subjects bag that was in close reach of the subject, during our interaction. Ofc. Sellers took possession of the machete and gave it to me to hold on to, as an officer safety concern. After attempting to verify the subjects identity multiple times, Ofc. Betz asked for a unit to respond who had an identity reader machine. Ofc. Rodriguez responded to our location with an Identity reader. I explained to the subject that we were not going any where until we identify him. After I told him that, he asked me if he could give me his ID card. He gave me a Drivers License (DL) that was issued out of Massachusetts. His Drivers License revealed his name is Donald D Myotte, with a date of birth of 10/18/68. Ofc. Sellers ran his DL number through Key West Dispatch Channel 2, which revealed Myotte had an active arrest warrant reference sexual assault on a disabled person. Ofc. Sellers asked that Key West Dispatch send for warrant confirmation.

Ofc. Sellers asked Myotte to put his hands behind his back so she could hand cuff him while he was sitting down. Myotte began to stand up while turning toward Ofc. Sellers. Ofc. Sellers clearly told him to stay seated while she cuffed him. Myotte stood up and turned toward Ofc. Sellers, grabbing her left shoulder and attempted to knee strike her with his right knee. Ofc. Rodriguez deployed his taser on Myotte. Myotte was on the ground still resisting arrest, refusing to put his hands behind his back. Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Andruzzi attempted to get Myottes hands behind his back, however, it was a struggle. Myotte also tried to bite Ofc. Andruzzi. Myotte was placed into hand cuffs. Myotte was escorted by Ofc. Andruzzi and Ofc. Betz, to Ofc. Sellers patrol vehicle to be transported to Monroe County Detention Center.

Ofc. Sellers transported Myotte to Monroe County Detention Center. I responded to the jail also, to arrest Myotte on the active arrest warrant. Myotte was charged with other charges by Ofc. Sellers. (See KWPD REPORT: 19-1492)
