A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A POSITIVE STEP OF MONROE COUNTY, INC. TO HOLD THE A POSITIVE STEP OF MONROE COUNTY 5K RUN/WALK ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 13, 2025 FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 11:00 A.M. (SETUP AT 6:00 A.M.) THROUGHOUT THE STREETS OF KEY WEST; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID RACE FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 11:00 A.M.; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, A Positive Step of Monroe County, Inc. wishes to conduct the "A Positive Step of Monroe County 5K Run/Walk" beginning and ending at Duval Street and South Street during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. (setup at 6:00 a.m.) on Saturday, December 13, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using Page 1 of 4

disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That A Positive Step of Monroe County, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That A Positive Step of Monroe County, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That A Positive Step of Monroe County, Inc. pledges that proceeds will benefit their services supporting high risk youth and their families.

SECTION 6. That A Positive Step of Monroe County, Inc. acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
