A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE U.S. PROCEED WITH PROCESS. CONGRESS TO CORPS OF ENGINEERS CERTIFYING THE ARMY RECONNAISSANCE REPORT AND DIRECTING DETERMINE FEASIBILITY STUDY TO WIDENING KEY WEST CHANNEL CUT B IS POSSIBLE; AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PURSUE FUNDING FROM PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SOURCES FOR THE FEASIBILITY STUDY: PROVIDING THAT THE FEASIBILITY STUDY SHALL BE AT NO COST TO THE CITY OF KEY WEST; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in 2007 the U.S. House of Representatives, Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure requested the Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) to determine whether modifications to the Key West channel were advisable, and the City of Key West requested ACOE to produce a Reconnaissance Study to determine the possibility of widening the Key West Channel to accommodate larger cruise ships; and

WHEREAS, the ACOE report was delivered in November 2010, indicating a significant Federal interest for national economic development in pursuing channel improvements, as well as significant environmental and legal challenges that would have to be addressed prior to any improvements being undertaken; and

WHERES, there was a public workshop on this topic on July 15, 2011, to consider the ACOE report, and to educate the public and take public comment;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1: That the U.S. Congress is hereby requested to
proceed with a process of certifying the ACOE Reconnaissance Report
and to commission a feasibility study to determine whether widening
Key West Channel Cut B is possible.
Section 2: That City staff is authorized to pursue
potential funding from public and private sources for the
feasibility study. The feasibility study shall be at no cost to the
City of Key West.
Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified
copy of this Resolution to the President Barack Obama, Speaker of
the House John Boehner, Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid, Senators
Bill Nelson and Marco Rubio and Congresswoman Ileana Ros-Lehtinen.
Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the
signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
