A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE GREATER KEY WEST CHAMBER OF COMMERCE TO CONDUCT THE "6TH ANNUAL BBQ RIB BATTLE" ON ANN STREET ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 31, 2025, FROM 11:30 A.M. TO 4:00 P.M. (SET-UP BEGINNING AT 9 A.M.); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Greater Key West Chamber of Commerce wishes to conduct the "6th Annual BBQ Rib Battle" on Ann Street between Greene and Caroline during the hours of 11:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 31, 2025; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative

environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That the Greater Key West Chamber of Commerce is hereby granted permission to conduct the "6th Annual BBQ Rib Battle" on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Greater Key West Chamber is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That the Greater Key West Chamber of Commerce must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. The Greater Key West Chamber of Commerce shall be responsible for paying the KWPD, KWFD and Community Services.

SECTION 7. The Greater Key West Chamber of Commerce will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used that that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
