A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY KNOWN AS "OLD FIRE ENGINE #5" AS A DONATION TO THE "GUARDIANS OF THE RIBBON-PINK FIRE TRUCK CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM" PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(3)(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Old Fire Engine #5, purchased in 1989, has passed its usefulness to the City and attempts to sell the vehicle were unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it would be beneficial to donate the vehicle to a non-profit organization;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the disposal of surplus "Old Fire Engine #5" is hereby authorized, by donating the vehicle to "Guardians of the Ribbon-Pink Fire Truck Cancer Awareness Program".

Section 2: That the City shall not incur any costs with the transfer.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
