

RESOLUTION NO. 26-_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA APPROVING THE "FIRST AMENDMENT TO KEYS OVERNIGHT TEMPORARY SHELTER (KOTS) AND ESSENTIAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEE HOUSING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT" (ILA) BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF, TO ALLOW THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT'S MARINE UNIT TO USE THE ONE-STORY NON-RESIDENTIAL BUILDING ON THE TRUMBO PROPERTY AS A SATELLITE OFFICE; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE ILA BY THE MAYOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, via City Resolution No. 19-295, the City Commission approved the Keys Overnight Temporary Shelter (KOTS) and Essential Government Employee Housing Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Monroe County (County) and the City of Key West (City) to allow the City of Key West (City) to use a portion of County-owned premises for the construction of a new Keys Overnight Temporary Shelter (KOTS) in exchange for conveyance of the Trumbo property to the County for use as an affordable housing site for Sheriff's office and other public employees; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbo property is currently used as an affordable housing site for Sheriff's office and other public employees with a one-story non-residential building containing approximately 897 sq. ft. for incidental uses; and

WHEREAS, the ILA is valid and in good-standing, and the Key West Police Department (KWPD) has requested use of the one-story non-residential building on the Trumbo property to support the KWPD Marine Unit; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into the First Amendment to ILA to include additional permitted uses of the Project, which would allow the Key West Police Department's Marine unit to use the one-story non-residential building on the Trumbo property as a satellite office;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the forgoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby approves the "First Amendment to Keys Overnight Temporary Shelter (KOTS) and Essential Government Employee Housing Interlocal Agreement" between Monroe County and the City of Key West, Florida, as attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 3: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the "First Amendment to Keys Overnight Temporary Shelter (KOTS) and Essential Government Employee Housing Interlocal Agreement" and any necessary related documents, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
