WHEREAS, on July 31, 2025, Invitation to Bid (ITB) 25-017 was publicly advertised in The Citizen newspaper and posted on DemandStar. In response, four (4) sealed bids were received and formally opened on August 27, 2025 in the Office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, following the bid opening, staff conducted a thorough review of the bids received by the City in response to ITB 25-017. Marino Construction Group, Inc. was identified as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder capable of performing the scope of work outlined in ITB 25-017; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the Mayor and City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to negotiate and execute a contract with Marino Construction Group, Inc. for the Wind Hardening of Fire Station No. 1 in accordance with ITB 25-017;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That, in accordance with ITB 25-017, the City Commission hereby approves the awarding of a contract to Marino Construction Group, Inc. for construction services related to the wind hardening of Fire Station No. 1.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to negotiate a contract with Marino Construction Group, Inc., in accordance with ITB 25-017, and execute any necessary related documents, administrative actions and budget transfers/adjustments, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Introduction

Background

On July 31, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. (Eastern Daylight Time), Invitation to Bid (ITB) 25-017 was publicly advertised in The Citizen newspaper and posted on DemandStar. In response, four sealed bids were received and formally opened on August 27, 2025, in the Office of the City Clerk. The following firms submitted proposals:

- Best Home Protection Window and Doors, Inc.
- D.L. Porter Constructors, Inc.

- Marino Construction Group, Inc.
- Pedro Falcon Contractors

Following the bid opening, staff conducted a thorough review of the bis provided to the City. Marino Construction Group, Inc. was identified as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder capable of performing the scope of work outlined in ITB 25-017.

Procurement

The total financial impact of this procurement is \$1,753,499.73. Of this amount, \$819,146 will be funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), with the remaining \$934,354 covered by other City funding sources. The project is allocated in the Adaptation and Sustainability/Adaptation/Repairs and Maintenance account number #108-3806-538-4600, Project Number AS38062202.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to negotiate and execute a contract with Marino Construction Group, Inc. for the Wind Hardening of Fire Station No. 1.

This addendum is issued as supplemental information to the Invitation to Bid package for clarification of certain matters of both a general and a technical nature. The referenced Invitation to Bid package is hereby amended in accordance with the following items:

4. Responses to Questions:

- 1) Q: Is there already lightning protection on the roof.
 A: There is lightning protection. But it is in disarray and will need to be completely replaced.
- Q: Will there be a designated lay down area?A: There will be limited space because of the traffic. It will probably in the back area of the station. This is to be determined.
- 3) Q: The specs on the louvers don't designate level E.

 A: It is plus and minus 130 PSF missile rated. Bill will double check. The overhead doors are currently three-quarter horse power. It will be upgraded to one or two horsepower. So, the wiring will have to be upgraded on the breakers. There is room on the panel.
- 4) Q: Considering scaffolding will be required around the building, are there any special considerations for the egress of the fire trucks heading in and out?
 A: There are three bays and six doors. So, there will be a need to close down a bay. It will need to be coordinated. But, all three bays cannot go down at once. It will be coordinated with the fire department.

- On the plans the louver schedule uses the Ruskin ELF6375DD as basis of design
- In the specification notes on the plans under Division 10, the Ruskin EME520MD is used as the basis of design
- The structural plans note this is a Risk Category IV requirement which under 2023
 Florida Building Code mandates an impact Level "E" certification
 - Neither of the noted models cited meet the impact level requirement as noted by their file product sheets and product approvals
- Due to the two different models, the ELF6375DXD being a drainable blade design, and the EME520MD being a wind-driven rain resistant design, which is the intent

Obviously, the basis of design is incorrect, so taking it back to a performance requirement, we pose the following questions with the basis being that any product must meet the impact Level "E" mandated requirement:

- Is the horizontal blade exterior design critical or can a vertical blade unit be used
 - There are vertical blade models which feature both a Level "E" rating as well as 98-99% wind-driven rain resistance at 8" inches per hour rain at 50 MPH wind speed without the use of a damper
 - If a horizontal exterior look is desired, one option is a combination unit (vertical blade insert behind the main exterior blades) which meets the Level "E" impact

requirement as well as meeting wind-driven rain resistance, as noted above, without the use of dampers

There are several horizontal blade model which meet impact Level "E" rating but to meet wind-driven rain resistance require use of a damper
