A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDED THE BID OF FLORIDA KEYS ELECTRIC, INC. IN RESPONSE TO RFP 006-12 IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$377,755.00, FOR CCTV AND SECURITY LIGHTING FOR THE NAVY MOLE PIER; APPROVING NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West leases from the United States of America through the Department of the Navy a section of the Navy Outer Mole Pier for the specific purpose of cruise ship berthing; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent payments to the Navy for use of the Mole Pier, the City has agreed to perform certain in-kind projects, including the work contemplated in RFP 006-12: CCTV and Security Lighting; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this project will be covered as an in-kind service through the Navy Mole Lease funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Florida Keys Electric, Inc. is hereby awarded in an amount not to exceed \$377,755.00 as delineated in the response to RFP 006-12, the terms and conditions of which are incorporated herein.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any contractual documents, with the advice and consent of the City Attorney, that are consistent with RFP #006-12 and the approval granted herein.

Section 3: That necessary budget transfers from Navy Reserves Account #602-1900-519-9800 to Navy Repairs and Maintenance Account #602-1900-519-4600 are hereby approved.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
